- Lightweight but robust enough to handle daily use
- Suitable, durable bag / cover for protection
- Suitable for use online and offline
- Security software

For all types of devices we recommend that:

- They be less than 4 years old
- They have AntiVirus software if appropriate
- Students make regular back-ups of critical work on external storage (e.g. external hard drive or USB drive)

From the start of 2017, students have been using Stileapp in their science classes as well as many other subjects. Stile is an on-line platform built for e-learning. Stile is used widely in Australasia in both primary and secondary schools, in all subjects, from maths to English and PE.

Stile permits learning through a social, digital and media rich medium, combining textbook, workbook and collaboration tools into one modern on-line space, accessible by students and teachers anywhere, at any time and on any device. Its ease of use and multimodal nature (ability to mix and match various media and question types) makes it easy for teachers to create engaging lessons and also give students real-time feedback to help move their learning forward.
